A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS
UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.**

Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the President of the Senate; and

Whereas, the President of the Senate has made his recommendation; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Dr. Ricky R. Sides of Forsyth County is appointed to the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners for a term to expire June 30, 1995.

Sec. 2. Frederick Lee Van Swearingen of Forsyth County is appointed to the Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management Authority for a term to expire June 30, 1996.

Sec. 3. F. J. "Sonny" Faison of Sampson County is appointed to the North Carolina State Ports Authority for a term to expire June 30, 1994.

Sec. 4. Carl H. Ricker of Buncombe County is appointed to the State Building Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1995.

Sec. 5. Bruce Mears of Nash County is appointed to the Board of Public Telecommunications Commissioners for a term to expire June 30, 1993.

1 Sec. 6. Barry Shearer of Mecklenburg County is appointed to the Child Day
2 Care Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1994. This is the nonprofit operator
3 categorical appointment. Marilyn Lee of Stanly County is appointed to the Child Day
4 Care Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1994. This is the for-profit categorical
5 appointment.

7 are appointed to the Administrative Rules Review Commission for terms to expire June
8 30, 1994.

9 Sec. 8. Jeff D. Rogers of Guilford County is appointed to the Private
10 Protective Services Board for a term to expire June 30, 1995.

11 Sec. 9. Debra B. Minton of Mecklenburg County is appointed to the North
12 Carolina School of Science and Mathematics Board of Trustees for a term to expire
13 June 30, 1993.

16 health care provider categorical appointment. Sandra Greene of Durham County is

19 and Blue Shield of North Carolina.

24 Officers and Employees Liability Insurance Commission for a term to expire June 30,
