A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION AND TO CLARIFY
THE APPLICABILITY OF LAWS TO AVOID THEIR CONFLICTING
INTERPRETATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The laws regarding employment discrimination may be redefined as they relate to the privacy of the employee.

Sec. 2. This act shall supersede and prohibit the enactment of any other local laws, rules, and regulations of State or local agencies and local ordinances which are more restrictive than this act.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
