- When the property is conveyed to another, the exemption ceases as to liens attaching prior to the conveyance. Creation of a security interest in the property does not constitute a conveyance within the meaning of this section, but a transfer in satisfaction of, or for the enforcement of, a security interest is a conveyance. When exempt property is conveyed, the debtor may have other exemptions allotted. The statute of limitation on judgments is suspended for the period of exemption, as to the property which is exempt.
- (a1) The statute of limitations on judgments is suspended for the period of exemption as to the property which is exempt. However, no judgment lien shall be valid more than 10 years after the rendition of the judgment unless the judgment creditor shall have, prior to that time, recorded a copy of the order designating exempt property in the office of the register of deeds in the county where the exempt real property is located.
- (b) Exempt property which passes by bequest, devise, intestate succession or gift to a dependent spouse, child or person to whom the debtor stands in loco parentis, continues to be exempt while held by that person. The exemption is terminated if the spouse remarries, or, with regard to a dependent, when the court determinates that dependency no longer exists."
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification. For three months from the date of ratification, upon application of either the judgment debtor or judgment creditor, the clerk of superior court may amend any order previously entered for the purpose of more specifically describing exempt real property.
