1 A SENATE RESOLUTION HONORING THE MEMORY OF GOVERNOR 2 RICHARD CASWELL AND CELEBRATING THE 200TH ANNIVERSARY OF 3 LENOIR COUNTY.

Whereas, Lenoir County is celebrating its bicentennial in 1991; and

Whereas, Lenoir County was formed from a portion of Dobbs County; and

Whereas, Lenoir County was named for William Lenoir, one of the heroes of the Battle of Kings Mountain during the Revolutionary War; and

Whereas, Richard Caswell, the first Governor of North Carolina after the independence of this country, was born in Lenoir County; and

Whereas, Governor Caswell served six one-year terms and is buried at the Caswell-Neuse State Park in Lenoir County; and

Whereas, the citizens of Lenoir County have been actively preparing a celebration to honor this historic occasion with a reenactment of the inauguration of Governor Caswell on April 26th, 27th, and 28th;
