Outdoor ad	vertising signs shall be erected subject to the following limitations:
<u>(1)</u>	The maximum area for any one sign shall be 300 square feet. The
	maximum area shall apply to each side of a sign structure.
<u>(2)</u>	Sign faces may be placed back-to-back, side-by-side, or in a V-shape
	construction with not more than two faces to each side of the sign
	structure. Double-decking of sign faces so that one is on top of the
(2)	other is prohibited.
<u>(3)</u>	No two signs shall be placed less than 1,000 feet apart.
<u>(4)</u>	No sign structure shall be erected within 1,000 feet of an interchange
(7)	or rest area.
<u>(5)</u>	The height of a sign structure shall not exceed 25 feet as measured
	from the edge of the pavement of the adjacent main traveled way.
<u>(6)</u>	No sign structure shall be erected closer than 25 feet to a highway
