A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL PRINCIPALS TO REPORT CERTAIN CRIMES
2 ON SCHOOL PROPERTY TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 115C-288 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(g) The principal shall report to the appropriate local law enforcement agency all
7 misdemeanors occurring on school property, involving personal injury, sexual assault,
8 use of a weapon, or possession of a firearm or drugs, and all felonies occurring on
9 school property."

10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993, and applies to acts
11 committed after that date.
