A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT RELATING TO DISQUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FROM  
2 BIDDING ON CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-  
3 SALEM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Board of Aldermen of a city may, by ordinance, delegate to  
7 the City Manager or the designee of the City Manager the authority to disqualify  
8 contractors from bidding on construction contracts of that city if the contractor failed to  
9 perform satisfactorily on past or current contracts. The ordinance shall:

- 10 (1) Provide for a definite length of disqualification period, not to exceed  
11 three (3) years;  
12 (2) Provide an appeal process; and  
13 (3) Describe the procedure by which contractors may seek requalification.

14 Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Winston-Salem only.

15 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
