- 2 AN ACT RELATING TO DISOUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FROM 3 BIDDING ON CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-4 SALEM.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen of a city may, by ordinance, delegate to 6 7 the City Manager or the designee of the City Manager the authority to disqualify contractors from bidding on construction contracts of that city if the contractor failed to 8 9 perform satisfactorily on past or current contracts. The ordinance shall: Provide for a definite length of disqualification period, not to exceed
