2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENT THAT A REGISTER OF DEEDS 3 STATE THE NAME OF ALL PARTIES TO A REGISTERED INSTRUMENT.

- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 161-22(a) reads as rewritten:

6 The register of deeds shall provide and keep in her or his office full and "(a) 7 complete-alphabetical indexes of the names of the parties to all liens, grants, deeds, mortgages, bonds, and other instruments required or authorized to be registered, and 8 9 such indexes shall state in full-the names of all parties, parties, whether grantors, grantees, 10 vendors, vendees, obligors, or obligees. For purposes of this section, a 'party' to an instrument means any person transferring an interest in real or personal property, any 11 person to whom an interest in real or personal property is transferred, any person upon 12 whom a legal duty or obligation is imposed, or any person required by some other 13 statute to be indexed. For purposes of this section, the name of a party may exclude 14 punctuation such as commas, hyphens, dashes, slashes, apostrophes, and periods that 15 may appear in the name. If the register of deeds chooses to exclude such punctuation in 16 the indexes, this exclusion shall be consistent for each party and shall be posted 17 pursuant to G.S. 161-22(g). The name of a party may also include abbreviations, which 18 shall be consistent for each party and shall be posted pursuant to G.S. 161-22(g). 19 Corporate, partnership, or firm names beginning with the word 'the' may be indexed 20 with the word 'the' placed at the end of the name or omitted entirely. Reference shall be 21 22 made, opposite each name, to the book and page or other location where the instrument is registered. All instruments shall be indexed on either the temporary or permanent 23 index within 24 hours of registration. The register of deeds shall not be required to 24

1 index an instrument that is part of a document containing multiple instruments, as 2 defined in G.S. 161-10(a)(1), unless the title of that instrument is shown on the first

page of the document and the additional registration fee is paid as required by G.S. 161-

 $4 \quad 10(a)(1)$."

5 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. Entries made pursuant to the 6 requirements of G.S. 161-22(a) prior to the effective date of this act that exclude

- 7 punctuation such as commas, hyphens, dashes, slashes, apostrophes, and periods in the
- 8 full names of parties are hereby validated.
