AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SECRETARY OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH,

AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO WAIVE REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS

FOR CLEANUP OF LEAKING PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE

TANKS AT PUBLIC HOSPITALS.

Section 1. G.S. 143-215.94G is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(g) The Secretary may waive reimbursement under subdivisions (1), (3), and (5) of subsection (d) of this section of all or any part of the costs of developing and implementing a cleanup plan for a discharge or release of petroleum from an underground storage tank that is owned or operated by a public hospital, as defined by G.S. 131E-48. With respect to a discharge or release from a commercial underground storage tank owned or operated by a public hospital that was discovered and reported prior to 1 January 1993, the Secretary may grant a waiver under this subsection without regard to whether the annual operating fee imposed by G.S. 143-215.94C was paid. In order to request a waiver under this subsection, a public hospital shall make a specific written request to the Secretary setting out the reasons for the requested waiver. The public hospital shall provide the Secretary with all financial and other information necessary to determine whether a waiver should be granted. The Secretary shall grant a waiver under this subsection only if the Secretary finds that the public hospital has cooperated fully with the Department in developing and implementing the cleanup plan and that reimbursement of cleanup costs would render the public hospital insolvent or would otherwise result in an extreme hardship to the hospital."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
