A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
STUDY RENTAL VEHICLE INSURANCE PRIORITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study rental vehicle insurance priorities for payment of liability claims when more than one insurance policy covers a rented vehicle. As a part of its study, the Commission shall examine and make a recommendation concerning the appropriate priority between the insurance of unauthorized drivers of rental vehicles, authorized drivers of rental vehicles, and rental companies.

Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report of its findings and recommendations to the 1994 Regular Session of the 1993 General Assembly, and shall make a final report on or before the first day of the 1995 Session of the General Assembly.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
