The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 12 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of twenty-six million dollars (\$26,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-six million dollars (\$26,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to ensure that every public school child in every class has a textbook or other appropriate State-adopted instructional materials.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
