A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH
COMMISSION TO STUDY A SYSTEM FOR COMPENSATING FOR MEDICAL
MALPRACTICE THAT IS A SUBSTITUTE FOR THE PRESENT TORT
SYSTEM OF RECOVERY.

5 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the advisability 6 7 of developing a system of compensating individuals for injuries caused by medical malpractice that is a substitute for the present tort system of recovery. The Commission 8 shall specifically consider the advisability of adopting a system for medical malpractice 9 that is modeled after a workers' compensation system. The Commission shall consider 10 the state model legislation developed by the American Medical Association for medical 11 malpractice. The Commission shall review the legislation from other states that have 12 adopted alternative approaches to the present tort system of recovery for medical 13 malpractice. The Commission shall consider the recent literature addressing fault-based 14 and no-fault based systems of compensation for medical malpractice. 15

16 Sec. 2. The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the 17 1995 General Assembly and may make an interim report to the 1994 Regular Session of 18 the 1993 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
