A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT RELATING TO ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen of the City of Winston-Salem may provide, by ordinance, for the use of wheel locks on illegally parked vehicles for which there are outstanding, unpaid, and overdue parking tickets. The ordinance shall provide for notice or warning, immobilization, towing, impoundment, appeal hearing, an immobilization fee not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), and charges for towing and storage. The City of Winston-Salem shall not be responsible for any damage to an immobilized illegally parked vehicle resulting from unauthorized attempts to free or move that vehicle.

Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Winston-Salem only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
