Section 1. G.S. 163-278.9(a)(3) reads as rewritten:	
"(3) Postprimary Report(s). – The treasurer of ea	ch candidate shall file a
report with the Board no later than the 30t	h day after the primary
election if the candidate was eliminated in the primary. If there is a	
second primary, the treasurer shall file a report with the Board no later	
than the 30th day after the second primary election if the candidate	
was eliminated in the second primary. 60th day before the general	
election. An individual who was defeated in a primary election is a	
candidate for purposes of the reporting require	•
Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995, and applies to all	

primaries and elections occurring on or after that date.
