AN ACT TO REQUIRE ENTITIES PROVIDING HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS TO
MAKE DIRECT PAYMENT TO GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES PROVIDING
HEALTH CARE SERVICES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:
"§ 58-3-170. Direct payment to government agencies.
(a) As used in this section, 'health benefit plan' has the same meaning as in G.S.
<u>58-50-110(11).</u>
(b) Every entity providing or administering a health benefit plan covering
persons in this State shall make payment, for health care services covered by the health

- benefit plan that are provided by any State, county, or city agency, directly to the agency providing the services.
- This section does not apply to the extent the agency providing the services has been paid for the services by or on behalf of the person receiving the services."
- Sec. 2. This act applies to every health benefit plan, as defined in Section 1 of this act, that has an inception, renewal, or anniversary date on or after October 1, 1993.
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
