A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON TEACHER EDUCATION TO
2 REPORT TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
3 COMMITTEE INSTEAD OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON
4 GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Section 96(d) of Chapter 830 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as
8 rewritten:

9 "(d) The Board of Governors and the State Board of Education shall, through the
10 joint council or commission recommended in the 1987 report mandated by the 1985
11 General Assembly entitled 'The Education of North Carolina's Teachers', jointly
12 develop a plan for monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness and impact of the efforts
13 to implement the objectives of the Report of the Task Force on the Preparation of
14 Teachers. Such plan shall include measurable outcomes and provide for the collection
15 of data and other information to determine the extent to which these outcomes are
16 achieved, and to determine to what extent the results are attributable to the various
17 efforts initiated by this act. This monitoring and evaluation plan shall be developed and
18 presented to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations by
19 February 15, 1988. The plan shall provide for annual reports of the findings to the ~~Joint~~
20 ~~Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations~~ Joint Legislative Education Oversight
21 Committee and to the chairmen of the House and Senate Appropriations Committees on
22 Education."

23 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
