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| 2 | AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT |
| 3 | PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE REGARDING THE CONTINUUM OF |
| 4 | EDUCATION PROGRAMS. |
| 5 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 6 | Section 1. A new Chapter is added to the General Statutes to read: |
| 7 | " <u>CHAPTER 116C.</u> |
| 8 | "CONTINUUM OF EDUCATION PROGRAMS. |
| 9 | " <u>§ 116C-1. Education Cabinet created.</u> |
| 10 | (a) <u>The Education Cabinet is created</u> . The Education Cabinet shall be located |
| 11 | administratively within the Office of the Governor but shall exercise its statutory |
| 12 | powers independently of the Office of the Governor. |
| 13 | (b) The Education Cabinet shall consist of the Governor, who shall serve as |
| 14 | chair, the President of The University of North Carolina, the State Superintendent of |
| 15 | Public Instruction, and the President of the North Carolina Community College System. |
| 16 | The Education Cabinet shall invite representatives of private education to participate in |
| 17 | its deliberations as adjunct members. |
| 18 | (c) <u>The Education Cabinet shall be a nonvoting body that:</u> |
| 19 | (1) Works to resolve issues between existing providers of education. |
| 20 | (2) Sets the agenda for the State Education Commission. |
| 21 | (3) Develops a strategic design for a continuum of education programs, in |
| 22 | accordance with G.S. 116C-3. |
| 23 | (4) Studies other issues referred to it by the Governor or the General |
| 24 | Assembly. |

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| 1 | (d) The Office of the Governor, in coordination with the staffs of The University |
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| 2 | of North Carolina, the North Carolina Community College System, and the Department |
| 3 | of Public Instruction, shall provide staff to the Education Cabinet. |
| 4 | " <u>§ 116C-2. State Education Commission.</u> |
| 5 | The State Education Commission shall consist of the Board of Governors of The |
| 6 | University of North Carolina, the State Community College Board, and the State Board |
| 7 | of Education. The Governor shall call the meetings of the State Education Commission. |
| 8 | The Commission shall be a forum for airing proposals and engaging in board-to- |
| 9 | board dialogue about issues the Education Cabinet is addressing. The agenda for |
| 10 | Commission meetings shall be set by the Education Cabinet." |
| 11 | " <u>§ 116C-3. Strategic design for a continuum of education programs.</u> |
| 12 | The Education Cabinet shall develop a strategic design for a continuum of education |
| 13 | programs. A continuum of education programs is the complement of programs |
| 14 | delivered by the State to learners at all levels. |
| 15 | The new design shall take into account issues raised by the Government |
| 16 | Performance Audit Committee of the Legislative Research Commission. |
| 17 | The design process shall: |
| 18 | (1) Include vigorous examination of all programs as if they were being |
| 19 | created for the first time. |
| 20 | (2) Compare the existing structures, funding levels, and responsibilities of |
| 21 | each system to the new design. |
| 22 | The Education Cabinet shall report to the General Assembly on the strategic design |
| 23 | it develops prior to January 1, 1995." |
| 24 | Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. |
