A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PERMIT RECIPIENTS OF TEACHING FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP  
2 LOANS TO REPAY THEIR COMMITMENT TO THE STATE BY TEACHING  
3 FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE YEARS IN SCHOOL SYSTEMS LOCATED IN  
4 LOW-WEALTH COUNTIES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 115C-363.23A(e) reads as rewritten:

8 "(e) The Commission shall forgive the loan if, within seven years after graduation,  
9 the recipient teaches for four years at a North Carolina public school or at a school  
10 operated by the United States government in North Carolina. The Commission shall  
11 also forgive the loan if, within seven years after graduation, the recipient teaches for  
12 three consecutive years at a North Carolina public school in a local school  
13 administrative unit located in a county that qualifies, the first year the recipient teaches,  
14 as a low-wealth county under the formula for distribution of supplemental school  
15 funding for low-wealth counties, whether or not the county meets the minimum effort  
16 requirement for distribution of funds. The Commission shall also forgive the loan if it  
17 finds that it is impossible for the recipient to teach for four years, within seven years  
18 after graduation, at a North Carolina public school or at a school operated by the United  
19 States government in North Carolina, because of the death or permanent disability of the  
20 recipient."

21 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
