A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REVISE THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF GRIFTON TO ALLOW
2 THE TOWN TO EXERCISE EXTRATERRITORIAL LAND-USE
3 JURISDICTION WITHIN TWO MILES OF THE TOWN'S CORPORATE
4 LIMITS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The Charter of the Town of Grifton, being Chapter 480 of the
8 Session Laws of 1975, is amended by adding a new Section 8-4 to Chapter VIII to read:

9 "Sec. 8-4. **Extraterritorial jurisdiction.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S.
10 160A-360, the Town of Grifton may exercise the extraterritorial jurisdiction powers
11 granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes within a defined area
12 extending not more than two miles beyond the corporate limits."

13 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
