2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF PARKS AND 3 RECREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO THE FORT BUTLER 4 PARKS AUTHORITY, INCORPORATED, TO CONDUCT SUPPLEMENTARY 5 MASTER PLANNING, FEASIBILITY AND MARKETING STUDIES, AND 6 LOCAL ECONOMIC IMPACT AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES ON THE 7 CREATION OF A STATE RESORT PARK AT FORT BUTLER IN CHEROKEE 8 9 COUNTY. 10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of 11 Parks and Recreation of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources 12 the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year which 13 shall be used for a grant-in-aid to the Fort Butler Resort Park Authority, Inc., to conduct 14 15 supplementary master planning, feasibility and marketing studies, and local economic impact and environmental studies on the creation of a State resort park at Fort Butler in 16 Cherokee County. 17 18

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
