Section 1. G.S. 18B-1004(a) reads as rewritten:

- "(a) Hours. Except as otherwise provided in this section, it shall be unlawful to sell malt beverages, unfortified wine, fortified wine, or mixed beverages between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., or to consume any of those alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:30 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., in any place which has been issued a permit under G.S. 18B-1001."
 - Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-1004(c) reads as rewritten:
- "(c) Sunday Hours. It shall be unlawful to sell or consume alcoholic beverages on any licensed premises from the time at which sale or consumption must cease on Sunday morning until 1:00 P.M. 11:45 A.M. on that day."
- Sec. 3. This act applies to all counties with a population of over 500,000 as finally determined in the latest decennial census.
- 17 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
