A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO FUND THE MILK SANITATION INSPECTION PROGRAM.

Whereas, it is in the interest of the public health and required by federal public health law to maintain inspections of Grade A milk produced, transported, and distributed from and within this State; and

Whereas, limited local resources have caused a decrease in the number of local health departments that assume responsibility for Grade A milk inspection; and

Whereas, the decrease in local responsibility for inspections has increased the burden on the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources to ensure that all inspections are made; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, the sum of one hundred eight-three thousand six hundred eight dollars (\$183,608) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred eight-three thousand six hundred eight dollars (\$183,608) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for personnel costs of the Milk Sanitation Inspection Program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
