NORTH CAROLINA BUILDING CODE THAT REQUIRE BUILDING
INSPECTION DEPARTMENTS TO REVIEW RESIDENTIAL PLANS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a county shall not be
required to review and approve detailed residential building plans submitted to the
county pursuant to Section R-110 of Volume VII of the North Carolina State Building
Code; provided that the county shall require and review such residential building plans
as it deems necessary.

Sec. 2. This act applies only to Mecklenburg County.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
