HOUSE BILL 1075

AN ACT TO REMOVE THE EXPIRATION DATE ON THE ENDORSEMENT TO  
SELL PROGRAM SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 515 OF THE 1993 SESSION  
LAWS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 8 of Chapter 515 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as  
rewritten:

"Sec. 8. G.S. 113-154.1(i), as enacted by Section 3 of this act, becomes effective  
December 1, 1993, and applies to violations committed on or after that date. The  
remainder of this act is effective upon ratification. The fees for endorsement to sell  
apply to endorsement issued on or after that date. ~~This act expires July 1, 1996.~~"

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 20th day of  
June, 1996.
