To obtain an H or an X endorsement, an applicant must take a test. This requirement 1 applies when a person first obtains an H or an X endorsement and each time a person 2 3 renews an H or an X endorsement. An applicant who has an H or an X endorsement issued by another state who applies for an H or an X endorsement must take a test unless 4 5 the person has passed a test that covers the information set out in 49 C.F.R. § 383.121 within the preceding two years." 6 7
