7	For the purpose of this Part, 'subdivision' means all divisions of a tract or parcel of		
8	land into two or more lots, building sites, or other divisions for the purpose of sale or		
9	building development (whether immediate or future) and shall include all divisions of		
10	land involving the dedication of a new street or a change in existing streets; but the		
11	following shall not be included within this definition nor be subject to the regulations		
12	authorized by this Part:

7	<u>(5)</u>	Within the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction, the division of a
8		tract of land in single ownership into not more than three lots, where no
9		street right-of-way dedication is involved and where the resultant lots
10		are equal to or exceed the standards of the municipality, as shown in its
11		subdivision regulations; and
12	<u>(6)</u>	The division of land zoned either Highway-Business or Industrial where
13		the resultant lots are equal to or exceed the standards of the
14		municipality, as shown in its subdivision regulations."
15	Sec. 2	2. This act applies to the Town of Rose Hill only.
16		This act is effective upon ratification.
