March 7, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY A PERSON SELLING OR GIVING ALCOHOL TO AN UNDERAGE PERSON SHALL HAVE HIS DRIVERS LICENSE SUSPENDED FOR ONE YEAR. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 18B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 18B-302.1. License revocations for selling or giving alcoholic beverages to underage person.

When a person is convicted of violating G.S. 18B-302(a)(1) or G.S. 18B-302(a)(2), in addition to any other action taken by the court, the court shall notify the Division of Motor Vehicles of the conviction, pursuant to G.S. 18B-302(g).

Upon receipt of a conviction report issued under this section, the Division of Motor Vehicles shall revoke the person's license as required by G.S. 20-17.3."

"§ 20-17.3. Revocation for <u>sellers and providers to underage persons and underage</u> purchasers of alcohol.

1	The Division shall revoke for one year the driver's license of any person who has been
2	convicted of violating any of the following:
3	(1) G.S. 18B-302(c)(1), (e), or (f); or
4	(2) G.S. 18B-302(b), if the violation occurred while the person was
5	purchasing or attempting to purchase an alcoholic beverage;
6	<u>or</u>
7	(3) G.S. 18B-302(a)(1) or (a)(2).
8	If the person's license is currently suspended or revoked, then the revocation under this
9	section shall begin at the termination of that revocation."
10	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995.
