6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 108A-41(c) reads as rewritten:
8	"(c) When determining whether a person has insufficient resources to provide a
9	reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, there shall be excluded from
10	consideration the person's primary place of residence and the land on which it is situated,
11	and in addition there shall be excluded real property contiguous with the person's primary place
12	of residence in which the property tax value is less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000).
13	situated."
14	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to
15	determinations of eligibility made on or after that date.
