G.S. 14-87.1 reads as rewritten: "§ 14-87.1. Punishment for common-law robbery. Robbery as defined at common law, other than robbery with a firearm or other dangerous weapon as defined by G.S. 14-87, shall be punishable as a Class G Class F felony." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
