A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LEGISLATIVE ETHICS ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO
2 BILL AFFECTING THE TAX ON A PROFESSION OR BUSINESS MAY BE
3 REFERRED TO A STANDING OR SELECT COMMITTEE A MAJORITY OF
4 WHOSE MEMBERS ARE DIRECTLY AFFECTED, OR ARE EMPLOYED BY A
5 PERSON DIRECTLY AFFECTED, BY THAT BILL.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. Part 1 of Article 14 of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is
9 amended by adding a new section to read:

10 "**§ 120-88.1. Conflict of interest by committee.**

11 No bill may be referred to a standing or select committee in either house if:

12 (1) That bill changes the tax on any profession or business; and

13 (2) A majority of the members of that committee are engaged in that
14 profession or business or are associated with that business as that term is
15 defined by this Article."

16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
