4	Section 1. G.S. 18B-603(f) reads as rewritten:		
5	"(f) Permits Not Dependent on Elections The Commission may issue the		
6	following kinds of permits without approval at an election:		
7	(1) Special occasion permits;		
8	(2) Limited special occasion permits;		
9	(3) Brown-bagging permits for private clubs and congressionally chartered		
10	veterans organizations; Mixed beverages permit for any establishment		
11	that qualifies for a permit under G.S. 189B-1001(10);		
12	(4) Culinary permits, except as restricted by subdivision (d)(5);		
13	(5) Special one-time permits issued under G.S. 18B-1002;		
14	(6) All permits listed in G.S. 18B-1100;		
15	(7) On-premises malt beverage permits and on-premises unfortified wine		
16	permits for a tourism ABC establishment."		
17	Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-1001(10) reads as rewritten:		
18	" (10) Mixed Beverages Permit. – A mixed beverages permit		
19	authorizes the retail sale of mixed beverages for consumption		
20	on the premises. The permit also authorizes a mixed beverages

2		and fortified wine permits and to obtain a purchase-
3		transportation permit under G.S. 18B-403 and 18B-404, and to
4		use for culinary purposes spirituous liquor lawfully purchased
5		for use in mixed beverages. <u>The holder of this permit shall buy</u>
6		spirituous liquor from the ABC system in their jurisdiction or if
7		there is none, from the nearest ABC system store designated
8		for sales to mixed beverages permittees. The permit may be
9		issued for any of the following:
10	a.	Restaurants;
11	b.	Hotels;
