1 "(b) The Commission shall consist of ~~15~~19 members appointed as follows:

2 (1) Three members shall be appointed by the Governor;

3 (2) Two members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;

4 (3) ~~Five~~Seven members shall be appointed by the General Assembly upon
5 the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives in
6 accordance with G.S. 120-121.

7 (4) ~~Five~~Seven members shall be appointed by the General Assembly upon
8 the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in
9 accordance with G.S. 120-121; and".

10 (b) G.S. 158-8.1(c) reads as rewritten:

11 "(c) The appointing authority shall designate two of the initial appointees pursuant
12 to subsection (b)(1), one of the initial appointees pursuant to subsection (b)(2), two of the
13 initial appointees pursuant to subsection (b)(3), and two of the initial appointees pursuant
14 to subsection (b)(4) to serve for terms ending June 30, 1995; the remainder of the initial
15 appointees shall serve for terms ending June 30, 1997. Their successors shall serve for
16 four-year terms ending on June 30 quadrennially thereafter. The appointing authority
17 shall designate the additional appointees under subsections (b3) and (b4) that were added
18 to the Commission membership pursuant to an act of the 1995 General Assembly to serve
19 for terms ending June 30, 1999.

20 Any appointment to fill a vacancy on the Commission shall be for the balance of the
21 unexpired term. Vacancies in appointments made by the General Assembly shall be in
22 accordance with G.S. 120-122."
