A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to be divided equally among the four chapters of the Alzheimer's Association of North Carolina, which are the Western Alzheimer's Chapter, the Southern Piedmont Alzheimer's Chapter, the Eastern Alzheimer's Chapter, and the Triad Alzheimer's Chapter.

Sec. 2. Each Chapter shall submit to the Division of Aging, for approval, a plan for the use of these funds, prior to receipt of these funds.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
