A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO SUNSET ANY ADMINISTRATIVE RULE ADOPTED UNDER
2 CHAPTER 150B OF THE GENERAL STATUTES TEN YEARS AFTER THE
3 RULE BECAME EFFECTIVE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Part 1 of Article 2A of Chapter 150B of the General Statutes is
7 amended by adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 150B-21A. Termination date for rules.**

9 All rules adopted in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 150B of the General
10 Statutes shall terminate effective August 1 next following the tenth anniversary of the
11 effective date of the rule. For purposes of this section, the effective date of the rule shall
12 be the later of the date the rule was adopted or amended."

13 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective August 1, 1996, and applies to rules
14 adopted before, on, or after that date, except for rules that became effective on or before
15 August 1, 1986, this act becomes effective August 1, 1997.
