5	Section 1. Chapter 51 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the
6	following new section to read:
7	"§ 51-1.2. Marriages between persons of the same gender not valid.
8	Marriages contracted or performed outside of North Carolina between individuals of
9	the same gender are not valid in North Carolina."
10	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
