SENATE BILL 156

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT FIREFIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL
2 SERVICE PERSONNEL MAY POSSESS OR CARRY WEAPONS ON SCHOOL
3 GROUNDS WHEN DISCHARGING THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 14-269.2 (g) reads as rewritten:

6 "(g) This section shall not apply to:

7 (1) A weapon used solely for educational or school-sanctioned ceremonial
8 purposes, or used in a school-approved program conducted under the
9 supervision of an adult whose supervision has been approved by the
10 school authority;

11 (2) Armed forces personnel, officers and soldiers of the militia and national
12 guard, law-enforcement personnel, ~~and firefighters, emergency medical~~
13 personnel, and any private police employed by an educational
14 institution, when acting in the discharge of their official duties; or

15 (3) Home schools as defined in G.S. 115C-563(a)."

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995.
