2	AN ACT EXEMPTING COLUMBUS COUNTY HOSPITAL, INC., FROM CERTAIN
3	RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Notwithstanding any rules and regulations of the Local Government
6	Commission governing procedures for the receipt, deposit, investment, transfer, and
7	disbursement of money and other assets by public hospitals, as provided by Article 3,
8	Part 4, of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes, Columbus County Hospital, Inc., the
9	Board of Trustees of Columbus County Hospital, Inc., and the Advisory Committee of
10	the Lamar and Janie Walters' Trust may retain up to twenty percent (20%) of the annual
11	income revenue of the Lamar and Janie Walters' Trust for the purpose of reinvesting the
12	income in equity assets in order to provide for the long-term growth of the Trust.
13	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
