A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE EMPLOYEES OF STATE LICENSING AND EXAMINING BOARDS MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 135-1(11) reads as rewritten:

"(11) 'Employer' shall mean the State of North Carolina, the county board of education, the city board of education, the State Board of Education, the board of trustees of the University of North Carolina, the board of trustees of other institutions and agencies supported and under the control of the State, any State board or agency charged with the duty of administering any law relating to the examination and licensing of persons to practice a profession, trade, or occupation whose employees are covered by the provisions of Chapter 126 of the General Statutes except for Article 3, or any other agency of and within the State by which a teacher or other employee is paid."

Sec. 2. G.S. 135-1.1 is repealed.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995.
