**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN ALZHEIMER'S UNIT AT THE  
NORTH CAROLINA SPECIAL CARE CENTER IN WILSON.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year, for start-up and operating costs of an Alzheimer's Unit at the North Carolina Special Care Center in Wilson. This unit will serve mid- to final-stage Alzheimer's patients.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
