A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE STAGGERED FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR MEMBERS OF
THE STANLY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 667 of the Session Laws of 1957 is rewritten
to read:

"Section 1. The Stanly County Board of Commissioners consists of five members
elected by the qualified voters of that county. In 1998, five members shall be elected.
The three persons receiving the highest numbers of votes are elected to four-year terms
and the two persons receiving the next highest numbers of votes are elected to two-year
terms. In 2000 and quadrennially thereafter, two persons are elected to four-year terms.
In 2002 and quadrennially thereafter, three persons are elected to four-year terms. Terms
begin on the first Monday in December of the year of election and continue until
successors are elected and qualify."

Sec. 2. This act does not affect the terms of office of persons elected to the
Stanly County Board of Commissioners in 1994 for four-year terms.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
