A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE GIVEN BY
2 CATAWBA COUNTY TO VETERANS WHO APPLY FOR COUNTY
3 EMPLOYMENT.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 631 of the 1945 Session Laws reads as
7 rewritten:

8 "Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Catawba County is hereby
9 authorized and empowered to employ a county veterans service officer and pay ~~him~~ the
10 service officer such salary as the board may consider just and fair and to furnish ~~him~~ the
11 service officer the necessary office space, assistants, supplies, and equipment to enable
12 ~~him~~ the service officer to perform efficiently the duties of ~~his~~ the service officer's
13 employment. In selecting ~~said~~ the service officer and other personnel, preference shall be
14 given to applicants who are eligible veterans of World Wars I and II, as defined by G.S.
15 128-15(b)(3), in furtherance of the policy of the State that, in appreciation for their
16 service to this State and this country during a period of war, and in recognition of the
17 time and advantage lost toward the pursuit of a civilian career, veterans shall be granted
18 preference in public employment."

19 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
