3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	Section 1. A Charter for the Town of Sedalia is enacted to read:
5	"CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SEDALIA.
6	''CHAPTER I.
7	<b>''INCORPORATION AND CORPORATE POWERS.</b>
8	"Section 1.1. Incorporation and Corporate Powers. The inhabitants of the Town
9	of Sedalia are a body corporate and politic under the name 'Town of Sedalia'. Under that
10	name they have all the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities conferred and
11	imposed on cities by the general law of North Carolina.
12	"Sec. 1.2. Map. An official map of the Town, showing the current boundaries, is
13	maintained permanently in the office of the Town Clerk and is available for public
14	inspection. A true copy of such shall be filed in the office of the Guilford County
15	Register of Deeds.
16	"CHAPTER II.
17	<b>''CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.</b>
18	"Sec. 2.1. Town Boundaries. Until modified in accordance with law the boundaries
19	of the Town of Sedalia are as follows:
20	An area in Guilford County."
