4 (5) Resident Annual Comprehensive Hunting License – \$30.00. This  
5 license shall be issued only to an individual resident of the State.

6 (6) Nonresident State Hunting License. This license shall be issued only to  
7 a nonresident. The nonresident State hunting licenses issued by the  
8 Wildlife Resources Commission are:

9 a. Season License – ~~\$40.00.~~ \$80.00.

10 b. Six-Day License – \$25.00. This license is valid for the six  
11 consecutive dates indicated on the license."

12 Sec. 2. G.S. 113-270.3(b) reads as rewritten:

13 "(b) The special activity licenses issued by the Wildlife Resources Commission are  
14 as follows:

15 (1) Resident Big Game Hunting License – \$10.00. This license shall be  
16 issued only to an individual resident of the State and entitles the holder  
17 to take big game by all lawful methods and during all open seasons.

18 (1a) Nonresident ~~Bear~~ Bear/Wild Boar Hunting License – \$100.00. ~~This~~  
19 ~~license is valid for use only by an individual within the State and must~~  
20 ~~be procured before taking any bear within the State.~~ Notwithstanding  
21 any other provision of law, a nonresident individual may not take any  
22 bear or wild boar within the State without procuring this license;  
23 provided, that those persons who have a nonresident lifetime sportsman  
24 combination license purchased prior to July 1, 1993, May 24, 1994,  
25 shall not have to purchase this license.

26 (2) Nonresident Big Game Hunting ~~License.~~ License – ~~\$80.00.~~ This license  
27 shall be issued only to an individual nonresident of the State and entitles  
28 the holder to take big game by all lawful methods and during all open  
29 seasons. ~~The nonresident big game hunting licenses issued by the Wildlife~~  
30 ~~Resources Commission are:~~

31 a. ~~Season License~~ – ~~\$40.00.~~

32 b. ~~Six Day License~~ – ~~\$25.00.~~ ~~This license is only valid for the six~~  
33 ~~consecutive dates indicated on the license.~~

34 (3) Game Land License – \$15.00. This license shall be issued to an  
35 individual resident or nonresident of the State and entitles the holder to  
36 hunt and trap on game lands managed by the Wildlife Resources  
37 Commission. The Wildlife Resources Commission may, pursuant to  
38 G.S. 113-264(a), designate in its rules other activities on game lands  
39 that require purchase of this license and may charge additional fees for  
40 use of specially developed facilities.

41 (4) Falconry License – \$10.00. This license shall be issued to an individual  
42 resident or nonresident of the State and must be procured before:

43 a. Taking, importing, transporting, or possessing a raptor; or

1           b. Taking wildlife by means of falconry.

2           The Wildlife Resources Commission may issue classes of falconry  
3           licenses necessary to participate in the federal/State permit system,  
4           require necessary examinations before issuing licenses or permits to  
5           engage in various authorized activities related to possession and  
6           maintenance of raptors and the sport of falconry, and regulate licenses  
7           as required by governing federal law and rules. To defray the costs of  
8           administering required examinations, the Wildlife Resources  
9           Commission may charge reasonable fees upon giving them. To meet  
10          minimum federal standards plus other State standards in the interests of  
11          conservation of wildlife resources, the Wildlife Resources Commission  
12          may impose all necessary controls, including those set out in the  
13          sections pertaining to collection licenses and captivity licenses, and may  
14          issue permits and require reports, but no collection license or captivity  
15          license is needed in addition to the falconry license.

16          (5) Migratory Waterfowl Hunting License – \$5.00. This license shall be  
17          issued to an individual resident or nonresident of the State and entitles  
18          the holder to take migratory waterfowl in accordance with applicable  
19          laws and regulations. The Wildlife Resources Commission may  
20          implement this license requirement through the sale of an official  
21          waterfowl stamp which may be a facsimile, in an appropriate size, of the  
22          waterfowl conservation print authorized by G.S. 113-270.2B. An  
23          amount not less than one-half of the annual proceeds from the sale of  
24          this license shall be used by the Commission for cooperative waterfowl  
25          habitat improvement projects through contracts with local waterfowl  
26          interests, with the remainder of the proceeds to be used by the  
27          Commission in its statewide programs for the conservation of  
28          waterfowl."

29          Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
