The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 58-3-152. Excess liability policies; uninsured and underinsured motorist coverages. With respect to policy forms that provide excess liability coverage, an insurer may limit or exclude coverage for uninsured motorists as provided in G.S. 20-279.21(b)(3) and for underinsured motorists as provided in G.S. 20-279.21(b)(4)." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
