Short Title: Soil and Water Conservation Plates.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE TO PROMOTE SOIL AND
WATER CONSERVATION AND TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE
SALES REVENUE GOES TO FUND WATER QUALITY AND
ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(22a1) Soil and Water Conservation. – Issuable to the registered owner
of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate
may bear a phrase and picture appropriate to the subject of water
quality and environmental protection in North Carolina."

Section 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled
veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates are subject to the
regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee
in the following amount:

11 Section 3. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

12 "(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the
 13 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway
 14 Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration
 15 plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the
 16 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), and the Natural Heritage
 17 Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, as follows:

29 Section 4. G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

30 "(b5) Soil and Water Conservation Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more
 31 applications for a soil and water conservation plate before the plate may be developed.
 32 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
 33 Plate Account derived from the sale of the soil and water conservation plates to the Soil
 34 and Water Conservation Account established in G.S. 143B-297.1."

35 Section 5. Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 143B is amended by adding a new
 36 section to read:

37 "**§ 143B-297.1. Soil and Water Conservation Account.**

38 The Soil and Water Conservation Account is established as a nonreverting account
 39 within the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources. The Account
 40 consists of revenue credited to the Account from the sale of soil and water conservation
 41 special license plates. The Commission shall use the revenue from the account to fund
 42 environmental education and water quality education in North Carolina."

43 Section 6. This act is effective when it becomes law.
