4	PHARMACY PERSONNEL, PHARMACY TECHNICIANS, AND ALLOW THE
5	BOARD OF PHARMACY TO REGISTER PHARMACY TECHNICIANS AND
6	CHARGE A FEE.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 90-85.3 is amended by adding two new subsections to read:
9	"(<u>q1</u>) <u>'Pharmacy personnel' means pharmacists and pharmacy technicians.</u>
10	(q2) 'Pharmacy technician' means unlicensed persons who spend the majority of
11	their time dispensing as aides to and under the supervision of a pharmacist and are
12	registered with the Board in accordance with G.S. 90-85.15A."
13	Section 2. Article 4A of Chapter 90 is amended by adding a new section to
14	read:
15	" <u>§ 90-85.15A. Pharmacy technicans; registration.</u>
16	Pharmacy technicians shall register annually with the Board in accordance with rules
17	adopted by the Board pursuant to Chapter 150B of the General Statutes. Pharmacy
18	technicians shall also pay the registration fee in accordance with G.S. 90-85.24."
19	Section 3. G.S. 90-85.21(a) reads as rewritten:
20	"§ 90-85.21. Pharmacy permit.

In accordance with Board regulations, each pharmacy in North Carolina shall 1 (a) 2 annually register with the Board on a form provided by the Board. The application shall 3 identify the pharmacist-manager of the pharmacy and all pharmacist-pharmacy personnel 4 employed in the pharmacy. All pharmacist-managers shall notify the Board of any 5 change in pharmacist-pharmacy personnel within 30 days of such change."

Section 4. G.S. 90-85.24 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 90-85.24. Fees collectible by Board.

8 The Board of Pharmacy shall be entitled to charge and collect not more than the 9 following fees: for the examination of an applicant for license as a pharmacist, one 10 hundred sixty dollars (\$160.00) plus the cost of the test material; for renewing the license as a pharmacist, one hundred ten dollars (\$110.00); for renewing the license of an 11 12 assistant pharmacist, ten dollars (\$10.00); for licenses without examination as provided in 13 G.S. 90-85.20, original, four hundred dollars (\$400.00); for original registration of a 14 pharmacy, three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00), and renewal thereof, one hundred 15 seventy-five dollars (\$175.00); for annual registration as a dispensing physician under G.S. 90-85.21(b), fifty dollars (\$50.00); for annual registration as a dispensing physician 16 17 assistant under G.S. 90-18.1, fifty dollars (\$50.00); for annual registration as a dispensing 18 nurse practitioner under G.S. 90-18.2, fifty dollars (\$50.00); for the annual registration of pharmacy technicians, twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); for registration of any change in 19 20 pharmacist personnel as required under G.S. 90-85.21(a), twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);-for a 21 duplicate of any license, permit, or registration issued by the Board, twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); for registration to dispense devices, deliver medical equipment, or both, three 22 23 hundred dollars (\$300.00) per year. All fees shall be paid before any applicant may be 24 admitted to examination or the applicant's name may be placed upon the register of pharmacists pharmacy personnel, or before any license or permit, or any renewal thereof, 25 may be issued by the Board." 26 27

Section 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
