A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR DRIVING A VEHICLE ON THE BEACH 3 IN CURRITUCK COUNTY. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. G.S. 153A-139.1(a), as enacted by Chapter 875 of the 1985 Session 6 Laws, reads as rewritten: 7 "§ 153A-139.1. Regulation of motor vehicles at beaches. 8 A county may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and prohibit the use of dune or (a) beach buggies, jeeps, motorcycles, cars, trucks, or any other form of power-driven 9 vehicle specified by the governing body of the county on the foreshore, beach strand, and 10 the barrier dune system. Violation of any ordinance adopted by the governing body 11 pursuant to this section is a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than fifty 12 dollars (\$50.00), five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment for not more than 30 13 days, or both in the discretion of the court." 14 15 Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1998, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date. 16
