- A qualifying private club located in a county defined in G.S.
- A hotel located in a county that has a population in excess of 120,000 by the last federal census, is bordered by the Atlantic Ocean and the Cape Fear River, and has a State port located in it."

Section 5. The provisions of this act are severable. If a court of competent jurisdiction invalidates a portion of the act, the remaining portions of the act are valid.

Section 6. This act is effective when it becomes law.
