G.S. 90-95(b) reads as rewritten: 7 8 Except as provided in subsections (h) and (i) of this section, any person who 9 violates G.S. 90-95(a)(1) with respect to: 10 A controlled substance classified in Schedule I or II shall be punished as (1) a Class H felon; felon, except that the sale of a controlled substance 11 12 classified in Schedule I or II shall be punished as a Class G felon; A controlled substance classified in Schedule III, IV, V, or VI shall be 13 (2) punished as a Class I felon, except that the sale of a controlled substance 14 classified in Schedule III, IV, V, or VI shall be punished as a Class H 15 felon. but the The transfer of less than 5 grams of marijuana for no 16 remuneration shall not constitute a delivery in violation of G.S. 90-17 95(a)(1)." 18 19 Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
